now design were asked by Southampton City College to take a Disability Discrimination Act audit and compile specifications and drawings for the completion of some works in order to make them fully compliant. The works included the provision of a new lift and an access walkway within a portal frame workshop in their Maritime Technology Centre in Woolston, Southampton.

Full drawings were produced and the project negotiated with one of the College's preferred contractors, ROK who have been used on a number of occasions by the college. Tight timescales were involved as the works needed to be phased over the end of the summer holiday and completed during the following half term and Christmas holidays respectively. **now design** had to ensure the project was completed during these times as the students were reliant on the facility being operational during term time.

The project was completed on time and within budget and the college are now compliant in accordance with the Disability Discrimination Act.
